Having Fun with the Number 100 Diversion con el número 100

Counting Groups of 10

(ages 6 – 8)

Count out 10 straws. Bundle them together with a rubber band or string. Now create nine more bundles of 10 straws. How many straws are there in all the bundles? Count by 10's to find out (100)! Try this with other small objects, such as 100 pennies organized into 10 piles of 10 each.

Estimating 100

(ages 6 – 8)

Using both hands, scoop up a handful of coins, paper clips, M&Ms, or other small objects. Estimate how many you have – less than 100, more than 100, or about 100. Count to find out. Divide the objects into groups of ten and count by 10's.

So Many Ways to Make 100

(ages 3 – 8)

String together 100 paper clips; make a paper chain with 100 links; line up 100 pennies; make cookies with 100 chocolate chips (10 chips per cookie); walk 100 steps; clap 100 claps; jump up and down for 100 seconds; count to 100 by 2's, 5's, and 10's. How many other ways can you make 100?

The Art of 100

(ages 3 – 8)

Draw a picture that shows 100 of something. Create a work of art with 100 cotton balls. Make a painting with 100 dots from a paintbrush or marker (use different colors for a more colorful painting!). Make a collage with 100 pictures cut out of magazines or other printed matter. Make the number 100 out of dough.

Contando grupos de 10

(Edades 6-8)

Cuenten 10 pajitas. Amárrelas con una liga o cordel. Ahora hagan nueve paquetes más de 10 pajitas. ¿Cuántas pajitas hay en todos los paquetes? Cuenten por decenas para encontrar (100). Hagan la prueba con otros objetos pequeños, tales como 100 pennies organizados en 10 montones de 10 cada uno.

Estimación del 100

(Edades 6-8)

Usando ambas manos, tome un puñado de monedas, clips de papel, M & Ms u otros objetos pequeños. Estima cuántos tienes - menos de 100, más de 100 o unos 100. Cuenta para averiguar. Los objetos se dividen en grupos de diez y se cuentan por decenas.

Tantas maneras de juntar 100

(Edades 3-8)

Encadena 100 clips; haz una cadena de papel con 100 eslabones; pon en fila 100 pennies. Haz galletas con 100 pepitas de chocolate (10 pepitas por galleta); da 100 pasos; da 100 palmadas; da brincos durante 100 segundos; cuenta hasta 100 de 2 en 2, 5 en 5 y 10 en 10. ¿De cuántas otras maneras puedes juntar 100?

El arte del 100

(Edades 3-8)

Haz un dibujo que muestre 100 cosas. Crea una obra de arte con 100 bolas de algodón. Haz una pintura con 100 puntos con un pincel o un marcador (usa diferentes colores para obtener una pintura con más colorido). Haz un collage con 100 fotografías recortadas de revistas u otro material impreso. Haz el número 100 con masa.
