Here are the games we played today, WONDER RED DAY! We learned all about the –ALL word family (WALL, BALL, TALL, SMALL) . You can play them at home.

TISKET A TASKET LET'S MAKE A BASKET CRAFT ACTIVITY

Campers used letters and markers to decorate wood baskets to learn the –ALL word family (WALL, BALL, TALL) and to express themselves creatively.

Encourage your child to make –ALL word crafts! Have him draw pictures of a WALL, someone who is TALL, or playing with a BALL. Help him write the –ALL family words.

WORD CHARADES GAME

Using demonstration flash cards that have both –ALL words and pictures, campers read and acted out –ALL family words while the other campers guessed the –ALL word they acted out.

Play at home with your camper! Act out an –ALL word (TALL, BALL, WALL, SMALL, CALL) and see if she can guess what you are pretending to be. Have her write out the word she guessed. Then have your child act out one for you to guess.

FREEZE DANCE RHYMING GAME

Campers played Freeze Dance the SUPER WHY way. The teacher called out a word. If it was an –ALL word, the children had to freeze. If it was any other word that did not end in –ALL, they had to remember to keep dancing.

Write out several –ALL family words (WALL, TALL, BALL, CALL, HALL, MALL) as well as several non –ALL family words (PIG, BIG, BAD, THREE, LITTLE, RED, BRICK). Put on your favorite music at home and have your child dance away. While he is dancing, show the word flash cards or just yell out the word. Make sure your child freezes when you show or say an –ALL word and keeps dancing if it is not an –ALL word!
