

## Day 2

Here are the games we played today, WONDER RED DAY! We learned all about the -un word family (bun, sun, run, fun). You can play them at home.

## FUN WITH MR. SUN

Each camper created a sun-man and learned to recognize —un words as they played with their suns. Campers learned to read and rhyme -un words as they express themselves creatively.

Practice the un family and other word families by having your child look for words in magazines and newspapers that belong to each word family. Glue the words onto poster board or construction paper and ask your child to read the word and draw a picture of it.

## **WORD FRIENDS THEATER**

Campers learned about word families. They learned how to use onsets and rimes to create words. They worked together to become -un" friends" and then put on an -un word performance for their peers.

Encourage your child to practice –un words by playing charades at home. Write different word family words on index cards and place them in a hat. Have your child pick a card, read the word and then act out the word. You have to guess which –un word he or she is acting out!

## WONDER RED'S WONDERIFFIC -UN RUN AND FINDING SUPER LETTERS

Red transformed the game "Duck-Duck Goose" into a rhyming fun run where campers got to practice reading – un words.

Play an -un Run at home, just like red light green light. Line up your child and friends one next to the other. Stand with your back facing the kids and show the kids word cards, some -un and some non -un words. Explain that when you show an -un word, they have to run until you turn around. If you catch them still moving, they have to go back to the start of the run. The first person to reach you wins!
